Abstract extension should have a maximum of 500 words and will be uploaded through the OCS platform of the UPV. In order to submit an abstract, authors are asked to complete the registration in the OCS platform first by using login/password details.

Please read carefully the instructions before uploading your abstract. All items in the Submission Preparation Checklist must be marked.

All abstracts will be peer-reviewed, and acceptance will be communicated by March 1st. Each accepted paper will be assigned an individual DOI.

For every accepted communication, at least one of the authors must be registered in the Conference.
